

CORRIGE DES EXERCICES SUR LES PRONOMS PERSONNELS SUJETS OU COMPLEMENTS

1) Remplacez les mots entre parenthèses par un **pronom personnel**
SUJET ou **COMPLEMENT**

a) Brian and Steven are not American. (Brian and Steven) are English.
Brian and Steven are not American. **They** are English.

b) Has Peter got a sister ? No, but (Peter) has got a brother.

Has Peter got a sister ? No, but **he** has got a brother.

c) This present is for (my sisters and me).

This present is for **us**.

d) I love Beyonce and Jay-z; I watch (Beyonce and Jay-z) on YouTube every day.

I love Beyonce and Jay-z ; I watch **them** on YouTube every day.

e) She works with Mark and she plays tennis with (Mark) on Saturdays.

She works with Mark and she plays tennis with **him** on Saturdays.

f) Mr Smith is the French teacher ; we have class with (Mr Smith) this afternoon.

Mr Smith is the French teacher ; we have class with **him** this afternoon.

II) Complétez avec le pronom personnel correct au lieu du mot entre parenthèses proposé en fin de phrases.

Exemples : John loves (JUSTIN BIEBER)

 John loves **him**.

Give your phone number. (I)

 Give **me** your phone number.

c) Please, tell **us** your name. (MY FRIENDS AND ME)

d) Here's your pocket money. Put **it** at once in your bag. (THE MONEY)

f) Is Mike speaking to **you** ? (YOU)
